Erin joined Bristol in 2014 and serves as the Civic Engagement Coordinator in the EEC, helping students build connections with the local community through Service-Learning opportunities.




Maria Friedman, MSW Internship Program Coordinator

Looking for a Summer 2022 internship? Check out these upcoming workshop dates in February. Preparedness is key when seeking and obtaining an internship.

Within a virtual 1-hour Internship Prep Workshop, students will work with EEC staff to:

- Review policies and procedures of the Internship Program
- Learn what to expect at the internship site
- Begin the process of developing a resume & identify internship sites of interest

To enroll in the Internship Program students must attend one workshop the semester prior to beginning their internship.
