- 4. The Financial Aid office will review your information, determine eligibility, and notify you via Bristol email if you've been approved to apply.

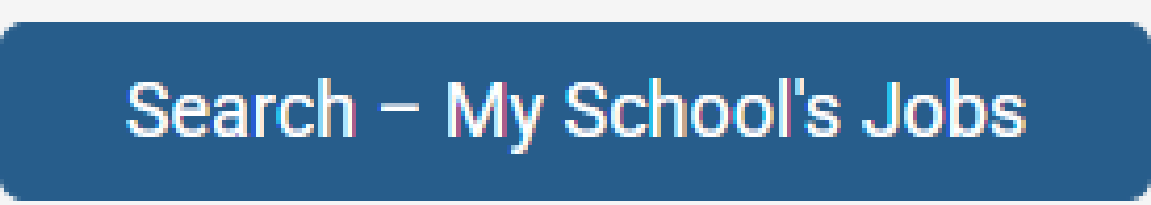

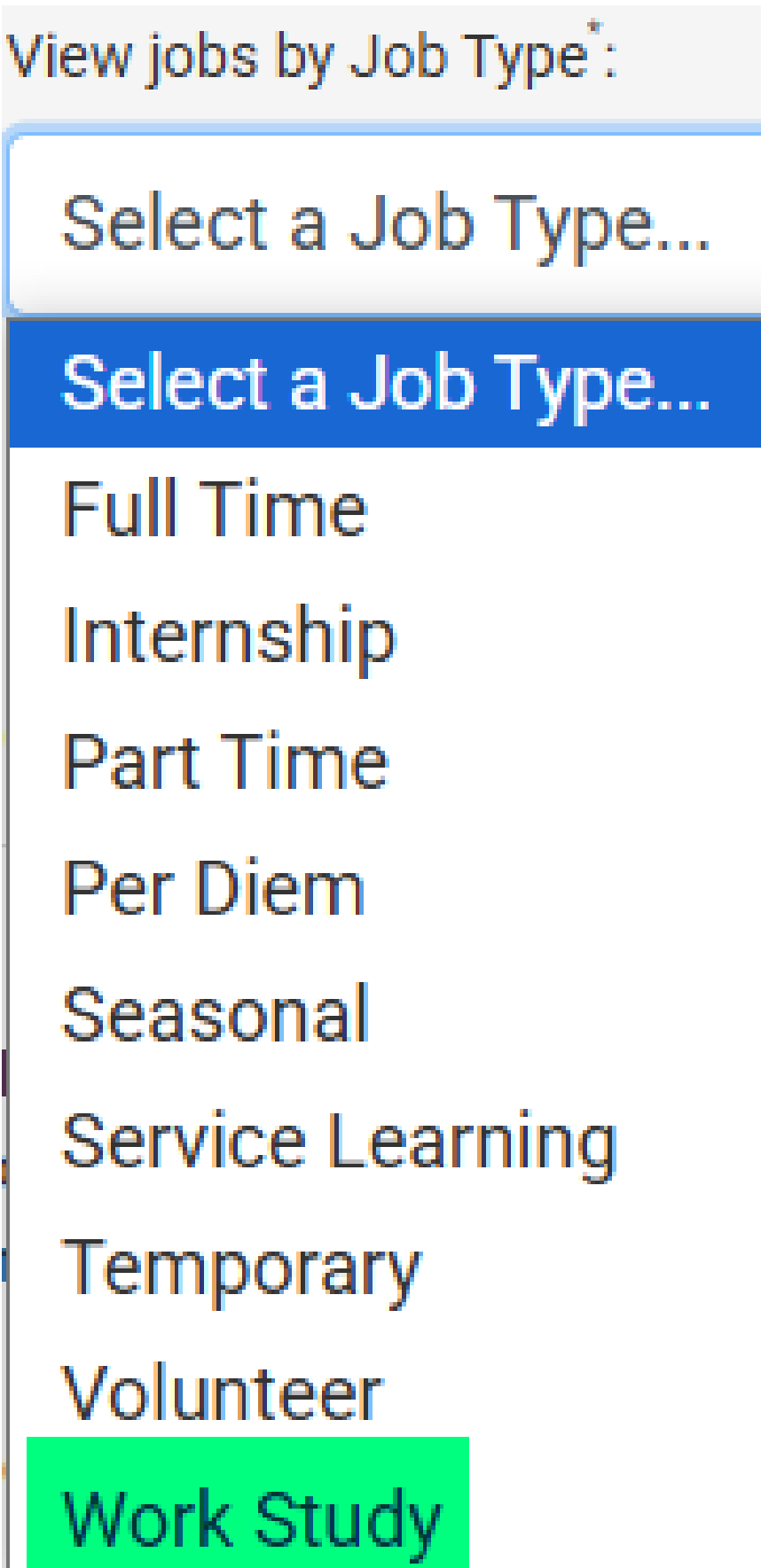
