Campus Preparedness Plan

- Every member of the college community must actively engage in promoting safety for yourself and others.

- Detailed information is also available on the Emergency Preparedness bulletin boards in every building on all campuses.



Contacting Campus Police

- If you see something, say something!
- Campus Police Contact Numbers (direct):
 - Business Line: (774) 357-2218, extension 2218 from campus phone
 - Emergency Line: (774) 357-3911, extension 3911 from campus phone
- 10 Blue Emergency Phones located throughout the Fall River Campus- press the button and it dials direct to Campus Police Dispatch.
- Alertus- press "Ctrl Shift F12" on your keyboard or the Alertus icon on the desktop to silently notify campus police of an emergency situation in your area.
- Text-A-Tip: Text "BCCTIP" & your message to 67283
- Remember, if all else fails, dial 911.




Emergency Forms of Communication

- Text Messages: sign up for BCCalert- this will quickly distribute information about emergencies. To opt in- Text the keyword "BCCalert" to 67283.
- Social Media- emergency notifications are sent via the college website,
 Facebook & Twitter.
- Campus Computers & College Monitors- these screens will be taken over to display the emergency notification message.
- Campus Wide Broadcast System- loud speaker on top of A Building (Fall River Campus), which will broadcast the emergency message.





Preparedness Flip Charts



- This guidebook is located in every classroom, office, and common area on all campuses.
- It lays out and organizes proper steps when dealing with many different types of emergencies.
- Topics Include: Shelter in Place, Evacuation, Fire, Bomb Threat Procedures, Active Shooter, Hazardous Materials, Lockdown, Medical Emergency, and Weather Emergency.
- Please review this flip chart (before an emergency occurs) to become familiar with all procedures of each emergency.

Campus Emergency Response Teams

- Campus Emergency Response Teams, also known as Building Teams have been established to assist you during the initial phase of an emergency.
- These teams are located in each and every building, on all campuses and they can be easily identified by the yellow vest they wear during an emergency.
- These teams members will assist you and ensure the proper protocols are being followed.



Emergencies & Students with Disabilities (ODS)

- Students should contact the Office of Disability Services or their Learning Specialist to discuss their personal emergency plan.
- Student should share their plan with instructors and/or another student in their classes, so they are aware that they may need help.
- Students shall spend time learning about each emergency procedure.
- During an emergency: look for the building team members who will be wearing yellow vests, they will be able to direct everyone to a safe place.
- If you are on the second floor of a building, go directly to the emergency station, which is located near the elevator.
- Emergency personnel and building team members will check these areas during an emergency.


