Bristol Community College is proud to announce that the college's nursing class of 2018 has achieved a 97 percent pass rate on the *National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX)* exam.

The *NCLEX* is an examination for the [licensing of nurses](#) in the United States and Canada. The National Council of State Boards of Nursing, INC (*NCSBN*) develops and administers the exam on behalf of its board members across each state in the United States.

“The college’s continued student success on the *NCLEX* exam illustrates the impact of the collaborations we have developed with the local health care providers and our faculty and staff’s commitment to helping students succeed,” said Bristol Community College Dean of Health Sciences Lynne Brodeur. “Thoroughly preparing our students to succeed on the *NCLEX* exam also enables healthcare organizations to have access to stronger recruits.”

Each state board of nursing requires a candidate for licensure to pass the appropriate *NCLEX* examination that corresponds with their education level. *NCLEX* examinations are designed to test the knowledge, skills and abilities essential for the safe and effective practice of nursing at the entry-level.
